
BUILDING LUXURY HOMES THAT ARE SECOND-TO-NONE

Urban Revolutions wanted to create a home that included many different aspects, while still maintaining a classic and timeless look. A Georgian-style influence is evident in the home's architecture. Despite its grand size, the home maintains its charm and boasts an unmatched level of detail.

Truly made for entertaining, the home's open-plan layout allows it to cater for up to 150 people or it can be closed off for smaller, more intimate gatherings. Although the home is spacious, it can be sectioned off into four zones to create smaller rooms and better manage temperature distribution.

The home features a spectacular two-storey lobby with wrought-iron detailing and a timber rail spiral staircase that is immediately striking. In order to cater to a growing family and its many guests, there is a ten-car basement garage, a home cinema with seating for 12 people and a three-floor, custom-fit elevator to easily access levels.

Complete with a billiard room and lap pool, which includes a negative edge to make the most of the spectacular views, the home also includes four bedrooms, a study and library room, and a kitchen/living/dining area.

The water feature is perhaps the most impressive; designed in such a way so as to give the illusion of water passing from the front of the home, through the lobby and out to the rear of the home before cascading into a waterfall at the back of the pool, which circulates the water back to the start. This water feature creates a seamless flow throughout the home, achieving a perfect transition between the living areas and the outdoors.
